

- Negotiation
 - Litigation
 - Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR)
 - Mediation
 - Arbitration

Mediation

- Informal consensual process
- Neutral intermediary mediator
 - assists parties in reaching settlement of their dispute
 - based on parties' respective interests
 - cannot impose a decision
- Settlement agreement has force of a contract
- Leaves open court or arbitration options

Arbitration

- Consensual procedure
- Parties submit dispute to one or more chosen arbitrators
- Binding and final decision (award)
 - based on parties' rights and obligations
 - enforceable internationally
- Normally forecloses court options



Why ADR for IP and Tech Disputes?

- Cost and duration of court litigation
- Internationalization of creation and use of IP
- Technical and specialized nature of IP
- Confidential nature of IP
- Enforceability
- Collaborative nature of IP creation and commercialization


Pre-empting and Resolving Technology, Media and Telecoms Disputes




International Dispute Resolution Survey

- 75% of organizations surveyed have a dispute resolution policy
 - Mediation is the most encouraged mechanism, followed by arbitration
 - The three most important elements of arbitration are: institution, seat, and confidentiality
- 92% of respondents consider arbitration well suited to TMT disputes
- 82% of respondents foresee an increase in the use of arbitration
- Respondents expect ownership of IP and <u>licensing of technology</u> to continue to be a likely source of disputes



WIPO ADR Rules (2021)

- IP and technology specific elements
 - e.g., confidentiality, technical evidence, interim relief
- Applicable to all commercial disputes
- Flexibility
 - Pre-structure entire proceeding
 - For most part can be modified by arrangement between mediator or arbitrator and parties
- For domestic and international disputes
- Singapore Mediation Convention
- Electronic filings and online conduct of WIPO ADR proceedings

Process Mediator with experience in IT/technology cases (WIPO list

procedure)

Mediation sessions took place entirely online with live interpretation (French and German) via WIPO-hosted platform

Result Settlement agreement within five months

A WIPO Arbitration of a Biotech Dispute

Parties European biotech company and North American pharmaceutical

company

Contract Development and license and agreement

Dispute Alleged deliberate delay in the development of the biotech compound

Basis Contract clause providing for WIPO Arbitration with sole arbitrator

Process The Center proposed a number of candidates with expertise of

biotech/pharma disputes, one of whom was chosen by the parties

Arbitrator held a three-day hearing for the examination of witnesses. On the last day of the hearing, the parties accepted the arbitrator's

suggestion that they hold a private meeting

Result Parties settled their dispute and continued to cooperate towards

the development and commercialization of the biotech compound

A WIPO Arbitration of a Patent Infringement Dispute

Parties Two North American companies

Contract Submission Agreement to WIPO Arbitration

Dispute Patent infringement dispute related to a European patent in the area of

consumer goods; litigation in several jurisdictions

Process Three-member arbitral tribunal

Detailed procedural and hearing schedule

Amendments of WIPO Rules: e.g. shortened timelines and detailed

provision on experiments

One-day hearing in Geneva including witness statements

Result Final award rendered within five months of the commencement

of the arbitration






