### **1. List any projects/workshops the committee has done during this period:**

The MC is in the process to get in contact with those LES societies wishing to host an International Conference (LESI). For this purpose the MC has sent a list (together with a model budget and a final accounting based on the current basis) containing the required planning steps to the interested societies, i.e. to LES Britain & Ireland, LES Russia, LES ANZ, LES Chile and LES Brazil.

LES Philippines was also provided with the same information. The MC was not able to establish a functioning information system to get the required information (break-even calculation, statistics, program etc). Therefore, the LESI Board has taken over to assist Patricia B. (Head of the OC, Organizing Committee) with regard of the final preparation. For this Conference, the “old regime” of the profit sharing model is still applicable.

LES SA (“Sandton” 2010) is expected to give a detailed presentation at the next Meeting in Manila (6 June 2009) The MC trusts in the experience of the head of the OC, Alan Lewis.

LES Britain & Ireland (London 2011) has announced to provide a full documentation according to the above described standards (Para 1) within the next days.

LES ANZ (Auckland 2012) and LES Russia (Moscow 2013) should bring as well a presentation to Manila based on the outlined content to make sure that these societies are aware of the impacts of hosting a LESI Conference.

LES Chile and LES Brazil have as well the opportunity to candidate through the described application process.

LES China has not applied yet for a candidature of hosting a LESI Conference (LESI "Shanghai").
