LESI 2020 Financial Summary

- In 2019 LESI made a profit of \$136,324 largely due to the success of 2019 annual meeting.
- The 2020 budget shows a loss of up to \$363,264, due primarily to the cancellation of 2020 annual meeting.
- We have reserved \$200,000 for Berlin cancellation costs.
- We will be unable to forecast an annual meeting surplus until at least 2022.
- We are enacting current and will continue to seek cost cutting measures such that LESI operates on a budget and can meet its obligations with recurring revenue streams such as annual membership dues.



LESI 2020 Approvals Sought

- LESI seeks approval of the 2020 budget.
- LESI seeks approval of an increase in the membership dues in 2021 of \$3 from \$64 to \$67 per person. It also seeks an additional increase of \$3 and \$4 in 2022 and 2023, respectively.
