* By November 30th and December 1st , 2022, LES Brazil and ICC-Brazil (the Brazilian chapter of the International Chamber of Commerce) have held a round-table called "Technology Transfer in Brazil - Where We Are and Where We Are Going To" ("Transferência de Tecnologia no Brasil - Onde Estamos e Para Onde Vamos").

The round-tables occurred on-line during morning period, where representative stars from the public administration and the Brazilian industries, together with Les Brazil and ICC Brazil members have debated about their experiences in dealing with the agreements related to the transfer of technology and its formalities.

The debate is welcomed since the Brazilian administration, particularly the Ministry of the Economy, is performing several studies to modernize the regulations and propose legislative changes aimed to modernize and promote the commercialization of the intellectual property rights.

LES Brazil and ICC Brazil members where complimented with free registration.

* By November 3rd,2022 the LES Brasil member Mr. Felipe Toscano have invited Mr. Fábio de Lima Almeida, legal manager at GDM Genética do Brasil to debating about licensing strategies in the field of new plant variety rights.

The debate occurred on-line at LES Brazil's page in Instagram (@brasil.les).

* By February 22^{nd} , 2023 LES Brazil have organized a roundtable to discuss about a recently issued legislation in Brazil, Law n° 14.286/2021).

This legislation is of extreme importance and blows "modernization winds" over the Brazilian exchange regulation. It brings changes in international agreements, particularly on the payment of royalties made abroad.

In order to discuss it Paula Mena Barreto (LES Brazil President), Candida Ribeiro Caffé and Tatiana Camplello (LES Brazil Counselors) have invited Roberto Casarini and Fabio Braga (Partners at Demarest Advogados, in the area of tax, banking and finance.

The roundtable was carried on-line at Sympla, a platform for events, and made free of charge for LES members.

* On March 8th,2023 celebrating the International Women's Day, LES BRAZIL has organized a debate on the role of women in the technological development of Brazil (*A Evolução Tecnológica no Brasil e o Papel das Mulheres*). It was held at the Sympla online platform.

The debate was moderated by Marcela Trigo (LES BRAZIL) between Claudia da Silva Oliveira (Vale Holdings B.V.), Liane Lage (former Director at the BrPTO), and Angelica Ravagnani (Astrazeneca do Brasil).

Marcela started the conversation recalling that LES Brazil has a longstanding tradition in recognizing women's competences in the field of the technology licensing in the country, and cited several feminine highly esteemed past presidents of the association. An optimistic debate occurred about several aspects of women practicing in the technological field; Claudia has brought insights about women dealing with a mix of challenges and pleasures when combining work and family day-by-day activities; Liane has mentioned that women have being playing an important role in several technological areas in the country, but there remains a need to attract more women to the so-called STEAM areas; while Angelica has mentioned about her passion about technology, she mentioned a need for more opportunities for allowing people to know about the importance of the technologies.

* On March 16th, 2023 LES BRAZIL and ICC BRAZIL (International Chamber of Commerce - Brazil) will host together a debate about Technology transfer in Brazil.

The debate is welcomed since the Brazilian administration, particularly the Ministry of the Economy, is performing several studies to modernize the regulations and propose legislative changes aimed to modernize and promote the commercialization of the intellectual property rights.
